Martin Luther King Jr.

Early Life

Martin Luther King Jr. was born on January 15th, 1929 in Atlanta, Georgia. He was the youngest sibling. His siblings' names were Christine King Farris, and Alfred Daniel Williams King. His mothers name was Alberta Williams King. His mother was the organizer and president of the Ebenezer Women's Committee, she was also a choir organist at Ebenezer. His father was a preacher, a baptist, and a missionary early figure in civil rights movements. Martin's wife was named Coretta Scott King and their kids' names were, Martin Luther King III, Yolanda King, Dexter King, and Bernice King.

Martin's white friends had to go to a different school from his, and once the school year started their parents stopped letting King come over and play. His mother explained to him the history of slavery and segregation. The schools he went to were, School of Theology, Crozer Theological Seminary, Morehouse College, Colgate Rochester Crozer Divinity School, Boston University, and Booker T. Washington High School. He was not rich although his family was. He was an American Baptist pastor and a civil rights leader. He traveled a lot due to that matter. He was also a Ph.D - Doctor of Philosophy. He had Meniere's disease, tinnitus, and cataract in one eye.

Accomplishments

Martin's accomplishments are: The Montgomery Bus Boycott which is a civil rights protest when every black person in Montgomery, Alabama refused to ride the bus in an effort to get rid of segregated seating, He also received the Nobel Peace Prize, the Presidential Medal of Freedom, and the Congressional Gold Medal. The March on Washington which was for African-American civil rights, and finally, there was the Selma March, which was very similar to the March on Washington but it was for voting rights for African-Americans.

Legacy

His accomplishments that still help us today include the Montgomery Bus Boycott, which helped us because now black people can sit anywhere. The other two were the Selma March and the March on Washington. They helped because today African-Americans have civil rights and voting rights.

Remembered

Martin Luther King Jr. was peaceful, empowering, and revolutionary. He had a peaceful approach, he was a good leader, and a unique revolutionary.

Death

King died on April 4th, 1968 in Memphis, Tennessee at the age of 39. He was shot by James Earl Ray on a motel balcony.
